RECYCLED GOODS DISCLAIMER

Council's aims to minimise the loss of resources and protect the environment by reducing litter and the amount of waste that is being disposed of in landfills through resource recovery.

Waste minimisation is an important part of Council's Waste Management Strategy. The sale of recycled goods is one-way council is attempting to re-use, re-claim and recycle resources.

EXPECTED CUSTOMER CONDUCT

All visitors must abide by the following at all times while onsite:

- Prices are set by Council Shop Attendants;
- Products are sold on a first in, first serviced basis;
- No haggling of prices is accepted;
- No smoking is allowed at Waste Facilities;
- No pets are allowed outside of a vehicle at Waste Facilities;
- Children must be supervised;
- Enclosed Footwear must be worn; (No Thongs or open top shoes)
- All directions made by BRC Staff must be complied with;
- No threats, abuse or aggressive behavior towards a staff member or another member of the public will be tolerated;
- Theft of any kind will be reported to the police (note: surveillance cameras are in place)

CONDITION OF SALE

Customers purchasing recycled goods are advised that:

- All items sold are re-claimed directly from waste facilities.
- Council has undertaken no sanitisation/cleaning of any items prior to sale.
- Items may contain contaminants, allergens and/or other micro-organisms which could cause or contribute to skin irritations, respiratory conditions or illnesses in some persons.
- Council strongly recommends customers properly sanitise/clean any and all items purchased prior to use. Council will not be held responsible for any contamination of items sold.
- All items are sold on an "as is" basis. Council does not warrant/guarantee the condition or working order of items.
- Council accepts no liability in connection with the sale, loading, collection or use of items sold. Customers must ensure all relevant legislation is complied with, such as:
 - Effectively securing your load before leaving site; and
 - Obtaining relevant transport licenses and permits prior to departure.
- **No refunds or exchanges apply.**



Items Prohibited from Sale

The following list of items are not to be sold due to legislative requirements, health and safety precautions, concern for the environment and upholding Council's corporate values within the community.

1. Electrical Goods includes any item with a power source.
2. Hazardous substances including fuel, aerosols, paints, garden chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, cleaning products, strippers of paint, oils, radiator coolants.
3. Items containing asbestos.
4. Weapons of any type or part of a guns, gun stock, barrel, ammunition, bows, crossbows, arrows, large knives or swords (e.g. ornamental samurai swords).
5. Personal or Pirated media such as photographs, videos, DVDs, USB/hard drives.
6. Pornographic or Offensive publications such as pictures, DVDs or items that would be considered to be an invasion of privacy or disrespectful to any sex, race or religion.
7. Vehicle Number plates or any form of personal identification of any member of the public.
8. Stainless steel kegs, bread crates, timber pallets or similar products that have marked on them "remains the property of".
9. Gas bottles or Fire Extinguishers full or empty that have not been debunged including portable aerosol and non-aerosol fire extinguishers.
10. Batteries of any type.
11. Emergency Alert items such as flares, emergency beacons, smoke alarms.
12. Mobile phones or Tablets
13. Childs Safety Equipment such as baby capsules, walkers, vehicle child restraints, folding and household cots, prams, strollers and bath aids.
14. CCA Treated timber intended to be used in high-contact timber structures such as picnic tables, seating, playgrounds and handrails.
15. Pre-dated CCA treated timber or similar timber that may contain significant amounts of arsenic/ other toxic chemicals.
16. Timber used for the purposes of firewood.
Highly dependable safety equipment such as personal floatation devices, helmets, harnesses, breathing masks, respirators, safety ropes and climbing/abseiling equipment.
17. Aquatic Toys including inflatable swimming pools, flotation devices and pool toys.
18. Children's toys which contain magnets or lead and including any toys for children up to the age of 36 months.
19. Food products inclusive of alcohol and tobacco products.
20. Pharmaceuticals
21. Medical equipment such as defibrillators, and life support equipment
22. Diving (life support) equipment such as cylinders/tanks, regulators, buoyancy compensation devices. Does not include wetsuits/fins and masks.
23. Balloon blowing kits
24. Bicycle helmets
25. Elastic luggage straps
26. Recovery straps for motor vehicles
27. Reduced fire risk cigarettes
28. Sunglasses & fashion spectacles
29. Trolley jacks and vehicle jacks including vehicle support stands.
30. Bean bags
31. Vehicle Tyres (with or without rims) used for their designed purpose or sediment control.



The following goods are sold as **PARTS ONLY**. Council does not guarantee their operation or performance:

1. All mechanical goods;
2. Wheelchairs;
3. Bicycles;
4. Boats and Powered Water Craft
5. Motorbikes, scooters including quad bikes, miniature motorbikes and self balancing scooters
6. Caravans, automotive vehicles and trailers or any parts of;
7. Blinds, curtains and window furnishings;
8. Exercise equipment including treadmills and exercise bikes;
9. Bunk beds;
10. Basketball rings and backboards.
