

School of Arts building

Information for hirers

The School of Arts Building was erected in 1888 and is situated in the main street of the Bundaberg CBD.

This State heritage listed two storey building has a curved internal staircase, offering unique photo opportunities for groups and formals.

Close to local government offices, post office, cafés and shops, the first floor veranda offers picturesque views of the CBD.

The building's striking pink façade and decorative arches make this venue a distinctive feature of Bundaberg's main street. There are two rooms, a meeting room with a kitchenette and an exhibition gallery. Both rooms are air conditioned and have ample lighting and power points. The meeting room is popular for group meetings, small conferences and training sessions involving 25 attendees. The gallery is ideal for small scale exhibitions and equipment is available for picture hanging on the fitted rails.


Hirers must attend a venue induction prior to their booking (please allow approximately 10 minutes duration) to be arranged in consultation with Council's Booking Office.
