Commercial – Bundaberg and Qunaba

Fees are set by Council after careful consideration of the costs to provide these services to the community.

Special burials	<i>Per 3hrs or part thereof – in addition to applicable tonnage weight</i>	\$150 ea
Waste contamination fee	<i>Applied when waste is found to be disposed of incorrectly on site</i>	\$350 ea

Waste definitions

C&D	Waste generated from construction and demolition activities as defined by the Building Act 1975, section 5 (includes infrastructure for roads, bridges, tunnels, sewerage, water, electricity, telecommunications, airports, docks or rail)
General waste	Waste generated from all sources except construction and demolition.

- Secure your load – make sure covered and tied down
- What items can be recycling and what is rubbish
- Sort your load to save time and reduce waste going to landfill

Free disposals	
Steel and other metals	<i>Eg sheeting, pipes, fridges, air cons, copper, aluminium etc</i>
DrumMUSTER	<i>Eligible agvet chemical drums (must be triple rinsed)</i>
Batteries	<i>Lead acid only (cars)</i>
Re-saleable items	<i>As determined by attendant</i>
E-Waste	<i>Electronic waste - TVs, computers, small appliances etc</i>
Trickle tape (T-Tape)	<i>Not Ag Plastics</i>
Paint (Wet)	<i>Up to 20L drums – disposal limit 100L max.</i>
Clean Fill	<i>Natural earthen material no greater than 100mm (no waste contamination)</i>
