## Commercial – Woodgate

Fees are set by Council after careful consideration of the costs to provide these services to the community.

Clean fill	<i>(earthen material - less than 100mm)</i>	NOT ACCEPTED
Clean course fill	<i>(earthen material - contains natural material larger than 100mm)</i>	NOT ACCEPTED
Dirty fill	<i>(min 50% earthen materials plus other wastes - concrete, steel, plastic etc)</i>	NOT ACCEPTED
Polystyrene	<i>(expanded)</i>	NOT ACCEPTED

Garden bags – green waste	<i>(standard size approx. 1m<sup>3</sup>)</i>	\$5/bag

Hazardous waste	<i>(including asbestos)</i>	NOT ACCEPTED

Administration fee	<i>Document authorisation – waste transport certificates, confirmation of disposal etc</i>	\$25 ea
Authorised disposal application fee	<i>Disposals requiring authorisation prior to disposal eg. contaminated soil</i>	\$150 ea
Special burials	<i>Per 3hrs or part thereof – in addition to applicable tonnage weight</i>	\$150 ea
Waste contamination fee	<i>Applied when waste is found to be disposed of incorrectly on site</i>	\$350 ea
Waste definitions		
<b>C&amp;D</b>	Waste generated from construction and demolition activities as defined by the Building Act 1975, section 5 (includes infrastructure for roads, bridges, tunnels, sewerage, water, electricity, telecommunications, airports, docks or rail)	
<b>General waste</b>	Waste generated from all sources except construction and demolition.

Batteries	<i>Lead acid only (cars)</i>
Re-saleable items	<i>As determined by attendant</i>
E-Waste	<i>Electronic waste - TVs, computers, small appliances etc</i>
